CHARGES FOR AMENDMENTS MADE TO CITES PERMITS AND CERTIFICATES AFTER ISSUANCE

Please refer to the above-mentioned subject.

2 We would like to inform you that with effect from **1 April 2005**, a service charge of **\$8.50** per request will be imposed for applicants who wish to make amendments to their CITES permits and certificates after they have been processed, printed or issued.

2 Please note that only the **Consignee/Consignor** (whichever is applicable) and **quantity** fields may be amended. No amendments are allowed on all other fields on the CITES permit or certificates except those mentioned above. Please also note that the destination country may reject the permit if too many amendments are made on it. Requests for amendments to CITES permits and certificates must be accompanied by a letter from the applicant/trader/company informing us of the reason and type of amendment to be made on the CITES permit or certificate.

3 In view of the above, you are strongly advised to ensure that all particulars and details of the consignment are accurately provided in the application form before submission to AVA.
