2. All applications for inspection services must be submitted at least one day in advance. Additional charge will be imposed for urgent inspection in accordance with the Control of Plants (Plant Importation) Rules.
3. Imported plant materials subjected to inspection, must not be opened or moved except with the permission of an officer of the Authority.
4. Any loss or cost incurred including cost of transport for the purpose of inspection shall be borne by the importer.
