TO ALL IMPORTERS, MPCA MEMBERS AND DECLARING AGENTS

AMENDMENT OF PLANT IMPORTATION RULES 2005

Please refer to our circular PR 5.1 dated 22 April 2005 on the import of regulated types of foliage from West Malaysia. Following a review, the fresh foliages listed below will be removed from the regulated list of foliages until further notice:

Aglaonema, Alpinia, Anthurium, Ananas, Calathea, Codiaeum, Cordyline, Cycas, Dracaena, Ferns (all), Heliconia, Monstera, Palms (all) and Philodendron.

2 This list of imported foliages will be subject to our post entry monitoring to reassess their status as pathways for regulated pests. The survey results will determine if there is a need for this list of foliages to be regulated.

3 Please be reminded that all foliages imported should still be declared in the Tradenet System. But the above list of non-regulated foliages will not require an import permit.
