



## **MEDIA UPDATE ON VEGETABLE SUPPLY SITUATION IN SINGAPORE**

### **Supply of Vegetables**

1 From 3 pm yesterday to 3 pm today, 772 tonnes of fresh vegetables were imported from Malaysia. This is 157% of the normal levels of imports from Malaysia. It follows the approval of another 36 Malaysian suppliers to export vegetables to Singapore, bringing the total number of suppliers to 110.

2 With this overnight surge in vegetable imports from Malaysia, vegetable supply in Singapore has rebounded to above normal supply levels.

3 As there is ample supply of vegetables available in Singapore, AVA would like to advise consumers that there is no need to panic-buy and hoard vegetables.

### **Situation at the Causeway**

4 AVA cleared 178 vehicles at the checkpoints bringing in 772 tonnes of vegetables and 423 tonnes of fruits. Two vehicles were turned back. One had been to Pasir Panjang Wholesale Centre, while the other was from a supplier not on AVA's approved list.
