SUSPENSION ON IMPORT OF POULTRY FROM BELGIUM

Belgium has reported a suspected outbreak of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) in the country. As a result, the Federal State Service for Public Health, Food Chain Safety and Environment of Belgium has banned the export of poultry. We wish to advise you that import of poultry and poultry products from Belgium is not permitted with immediate effect. This includes products on waters.
