



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PASIR PANJANG VEGETABLE WHOLESALE MARKET

The Pasir Panjang Vegetable Wholesale Market (PPWC) will be closed for 3 days due to discovery of a case of a probable SARS infection affecting one of the persons working there. The closure of the market is to facilitate a thorough cleaning and disinfection of the premises. The market will be reopened as soon as it has been satisfactorily disinfected.

2 During the closure, there will be a temporary partial disruption of fresh vegetable supply. However, vegetables will continue to be supplied directly to supermarkets and three other smaller distribution centers. In addition, vegetables will continue to be imported from China, Australia, USA etc and channelled directly to coldrooms at other facilities.

3 AVA would like to assure the public that the vegetables available in the market are safe for consumption.
