### **PORK FROM IRELAND**

The Irish government has recalled all Irish pork products produced from pigs slaughtered in Ireland after laboratory results of animal feed and pork fat samples obtained by the Food Safety Authority of Ireland (FSAI) confirmed the presence of dioxins.

2 AVA will not accept any further pork import from Ireland pending investigation and clarification by the Irish authority.

3 For any Irish pork and pork products derived from pigs slaughtered on and after 1 September 2008, which have been imported into Singapore, AVA requires that you trace back and recall all such products from the market immediately.
