RE: EXPORT HEALTH CERTIFICATION FOR PETS

We have encountered applications for Veterinary Certificates for the export of dogs and cats from Singapore that did not comply with the destination country's import requirements. Some common non-compliances include:

- a) Animal microchip number not corresponding to the microchip number on the import permit
- b) Vaccination not given on the correct dates
- c) Inappropriate external parasite treatment

2 Please be reminded that it is the responsibility of the exporter to ensure that animals to be exported fully comply with the import requirements of the destination country.

3 AVA will not endorse Veterinary Certificates if they do not fully comply with the import requirements of the destination country.
